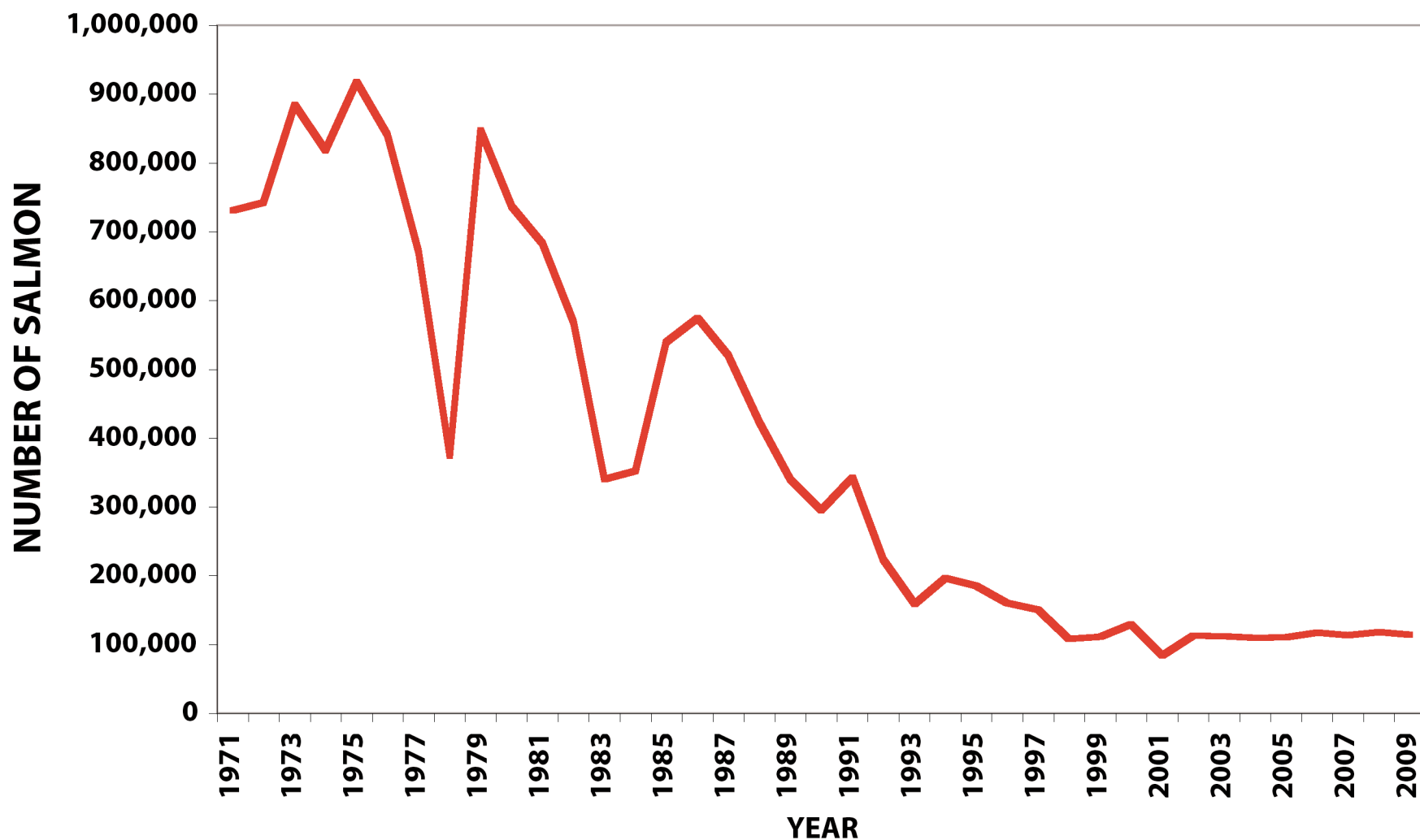


## Two-Sea-Winter Salmon



The graph depicts the number of North American large salmon that spend two years feeding in Greenland territorial waters, 11 months before their return. The graph includes predictions for 2007 to 2009. These large salmon are particularly important for their greater egg deposition on spawning grounds.
